1. Purpose	The Board of School Directors (“Board”) of Springfield School District (“District”) shall provide a comprehensive instructional program to serve the educational needs of the children of the District.
2. Definition	<p>For purposes of this policy, a course of study shall be defined as the planned course which consists of at least:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Written statement of objectives to be achieved by students. 2. Identification of PA Standards addressed through course content. 3. Content to be used to reach objectives for which credit is awarded at secondary school levels. 4. Expected levels of achievement. 5. Procedures for evaluation.
