Purpose

It is the policy of the Board of School Directors ("Board") that the Springfield School District ("District") may conduct a summer program of instruction for resident and nonresident students of this District as resources permit. [\[1\]](#)[\[2\]](#)[\[3\]](#)[\[4\]](#)[\[5\]](#)

In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board will:

1. Employ teaching and administrative staff.
2. Purchase such books, materials, supplies, and equipment as may be necessary.
3. Utilize school or other facilities as required. [\[4\]](#)
4. Provide necessary custodial services.

Tuition fees shall be charged to all students who participate.

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent shall be responsible for developing regulations for:

1. Planning the summer school curriculum.
2. Recommending appropriate staff appointments.
3. Student and staff assignments.
4. Utilization of facilities.

Such regulations for the operation of the summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions of this District.
