<p>1. Purpose SC 1806, 1807 Title 22 Sec. 4.31, 12.41, 339.2</p>	<p>The Board of School Directors (“Board”) of Springfield School District (“District”) recognizes the value of a diversified education program. One choice available to students is vocational education. The Board directs the administration to develop and provide a program of vocational education:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To prepare students for gainful employment in recognized occupations and in new or emerging occupations.</li> <li>2. To prepare students for enrollment in advanced or skilled vocational and technical education programs.</li> <li>3. To assist students in the making of informed and meaningful occupational choices.</li> </ol>
<p>2. Authority SC 1807,1841 Title 22 Sec. 4.31, 339.2</p>	<p>The Board shall support a program of career and technical education for District students attending Delaware County Community College and Delaware County Intermediate Unit/Delaware County Technical Schools.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>All students participating in vocational education programs supervised by this District are considered to be regularly enrolled in the schools of this District, and are subject to the policies and rules of this District, and jointly established policies and rules of this District and the Delaware County Vocational-Technical School, including rules regarding attendance for those periods when they are not assigned to outside work project, or other classes.</p> <p>The District will comply with school code for any applications or requirements.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall seek and utilize all available state and federal resources of revenue for the financial support of vocational education in this District.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
