### **Purpose**

The Board of School Directors (“Board”) of Springfield School District (“District”) is committed to being a friend and steward of the environment. As a steward of the environment, the District shall educate faculty, support personnel, and students of the intent and spirit of all federal, state and local environmental rules including the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act (Commonwealth of PA Act 1988-101).

### **Authority**

The District programs shall promote stewardship by addressing environmental issues such as finite/renewal resources, local and global impact of human activity on the environment, and individual awareness and responsibility. Extracurricular programs shall be encouraged to promote student stewardship and a raised level of consciousness of the environment and environmental concerns.

The District, in its commitment to operate in an environmentally responsible manner, will purchase, whenever possible and available, supplies that are recyclable and/or made from recycled material.

### **Delegation of Responsibility**

The Superintendent and/or designee(s) shall be responsible for developing administrative guidelines and procedures to ensure the implementation of this policy.
