717. REGULATING STUDENT ISSUED TECHNOLOGY DEVICES

1. Authority

The Board of School Directors (“Board”) of Springfield School District (“District”) recognizes the value of integrating technology with education. Along with the issuance of technology comes the necessary task of tracking and maintaining records and user responsibility for this equipment.

The Board directs, through the Superintendent, Executive Director of Operations or their designee, that appropriate tools be developed and implemented to assure that students using such technology shall be held accountable for using, storing, protecting, and preventing harm to these devices within their power. These tracking tools will be presented to the students prior to the issuance of this equipment for signing and will be held as file records by the Director of Technology in the appropriate repository.

Upon the completion of the program requiring the technology device, the equipment will be returned to the District for refurbishing or updating and re-issuance to the next user or removed from service as it is replaced with more advanced technology.
