Purpose

Buildings, fields, facilities, and other property items of Springfield School District (“District”) owned by the District are maintained by the District for the purpose of educating the children of the Springfield and Morton communities. District property shall be developed and maintained according to facilities plans and as approved by the Board of School Directors (“Board”).

Signs appearing on District property shall be posted with the intention of identifying such property as a part of the District and shall conform to standards set by the administration and approved by the Board.

Temporary signs and postings identifying school events may be posted on District property after review by and approval of the Executive Director of Operations or his designee.

Temporary signs and postings for community events may, at the discretion of the administration, be displayed on District property, provided that they do not violate municipal regulations and they adhere to District guidelines. Political signage is not permitted. The guidelines shall be prepared and maintained by the Superintendent or Executive Director of Operations and approved by the Board.
