SSD Internet Safety Policy

CIPA = Children's Internet Compliance Act

School must comply with CIPA requirements in order to be eligible for *Schools and Libraries (E-rate) Program* discounts on internet access, services, and equipment for internet connections and maintenance of those connections.

Requirements for CIPA Compliance:

- 1. Internet Safety Policy
- 2. Technology Protection Measure
- 3. Public Notice or Meeting



1. Internet Safety Policy

The policy must address:

- access to inappropriate content on the internet,
- safety of minors when using email and other forms of direct electronic communications,
- unauthorized access including "hacking" and other unlawful activities by minors online,
- unauthorized disclosure, use, and dissemination of personal information regarding minors.
- measures designed to restrict minors' access to materials harmful to minors.

The policy must also include monitoring the online activities of minors.



2. Technology Protection Measure

A technology protection measure is a specific technology that blocks or filters internet access.

Schools must enforce the operation of the technology protection measure during the use of its computers with Internet access.
