230. PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS	
1. Purpose	The Board of School Directors (“Board”) of Springfield School District (“District”) recognizes the value to students of sharing their talents and skills with the community through student participation and performances in public events held off of school premises.
2. Authority SC 510	<p>The Board endorses such performances when:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. They constitute a learning experience which contributes to the educational process; they do not interfere with other scheduled activities of the school. 2. The circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety and well-being of the students who will be involved.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>All requests for public performances by student groups require the approval of the Superintendent or designee.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop guidelines to implement this policy which require that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Parental permission is sought and received before students may participate. 2. No student, group of students or employees of this District may receive compensation for the performance in public of students organized as a school representative. 3. The interests of students are protected and guarded against exploitation. 4.
