<p>211. STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE</p>	
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Board of School Directors (“Board”) of Springfield School District (“District”) recognizes the need for insurance coverage for unforeseen accidents which may occur to students in the course of attendance at school or student participation in the athletic and extracurricular programs of the schools.</p>
<p>2. Authority</p>	<p>The District will provide parents the opportunity to purchase insurance coverage, at no cost to the Board, for injury resulting from accidents sustained by students in school programs, school activities, and while traveling between home and school other than a school bus.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Executive Director of Operations shall prepare specifications and secure suitable coverage from qualified insurance carriers for recommendation and Board consideration and notify all students and parents of students who may be eligible for insurance.</p> <p><b><u>DISCLAIMERS:</u></b></p> <p><b><i>This policy is superseded by all current federal and state laws and mandates.</i></b></p> <p><b><i>This online posting is an electronic copy from Springfield School District’s manual of currently adopted policies.
