

Pol. 221	<p>No student has the right to interfere with the education of his/her fellow students. It is the responsibility of each student to respect the rights of teachers, students, administrators and all others who are involved in the educational process.</p> <p>Students should express their ideas and opinions in a respectful manner so as not to offend or slander others.</p> <p>It is the responsibility of the students to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Be aware of all rules and regulations for student behavior and conduct themselves in accord with them.2. Be willing to volunteer information in matters relating the health, safety and welfare of the school community and the protection of school property.3. Dress and groom themselves so as to meet fair standards of safety and health, and so as not to cause substantial disruption to the educational processes.4. Assume that until a rule is waived, altered or repealed it is in full effect.5. Assist the school staff in operating a safe school for all students enrolled therein.6. Be aware of and comply with state and local laws.7. Exercise proper care when using public facilities and equipment.8. Attend school daily, except when excused, and be on time at all classes and other school functions.9. Do not leave the building and/or school grounds between arrival and dismissal time without permission.10. Make all necessary arrangements for making up work when absent from school.11. Pursue and attempt to complete satisfactorily the courses of study prescribed by state and local school authorities.12. Avoid inaccuracies in student newspapers or publications and indecent or obscene language.
