### **Authority**

The Springfield School District ("District") will permit the use of motor vehicles in appropriate areas of District property by students in accordance with the rules of the district.

Students must register their cars with the administration to secure a parking permit.

The District will not be responsible for motor vehicles and their contents which are lost, stolen, or damaged. Any vehicle on District property is subject to search per Policy No. 226, School Search and Seizure.[1]

Violations of parking regulations or any poor driving practices considered to be reckless, unsafe, or discourteous will bring about restrictions of the driving and parking privileges. The operation of any motor vehicle in a manner which violates local or state laws will be reported to the Springfield Police Department.

### **Delegation of Responsibility**

The Superintendent or his designee shall develop rules and regulations for the operation and parking of motor vehicles and shall disseminate those rules to all students so affected.

The Superintendent or his designee will develop and publish administrative guidelines which are consistent with this policy.
