## What to Expect in the Coming Weeks

- <u>Placement Letters:</u> We will mail a physical letter indicating your child's homeroom placement. Kindergarten letters will be placed in the mail by August 24; letters for Grades 1 through 5 will be placed in the mail on August 26. Please be on the lookout for the letter shortly after that date.
- <u>Individual Schedules</u>- Virtual schedules will vary by grade level, classroom, and required services. Your child's schedule will be included with the materials distribution
- <u>Ongoing Communication</u>- We will continue to communicate with you regarding login information, emergency information, etc. via email prior to the start of school on September 8.

#### **Materials Distribution**

- <u>Chromebooks</u>: The district will provide Chromebooks to students who need them. A survey will be sent out on Wednesday, August 19. Please complete that form, and we will include a Chromebook when you pick up your child's learning materials on September 1 or 2. If your child already has a personal laptop or a district-issued device from the spring, they will not need a district-issued Chromebook for the fall.
- <u>Learning Materials:</u> Distribution of curriculum-related books and materials (i.e. math and reading workbooks, etc.) will take place on September 1 & 2 at your child's school. If you have more than one child in the same school, you make pick up all materials at one time.

## **Learning Platforms**



#### **Canvas**

- The district has adopted the Canvas platform as our learning management system. Canvas allows a more robust virtual learning experience for our students, with a combination of synchronous (face-to-face) and asynchronous (independent) learning opportunities in a safe online environment.
- The Canvas platform is new for our students and families. Our technology
  department is currently creating instructional videos to introduce Canvas to
  our students. The teachers will also instruct students on Canvas once
  school starts, as they did with the platforms we used in the spring. You can

- Teachers will help students learn and navigate the system during the first day(s) of school.

#### Zoom

 All teachers will have personal Zoom accounts for live/ synchronous instruction and meetings. The Zoom links will be included in the Canvas platform so students can easily access the teachers' live instruction.
