

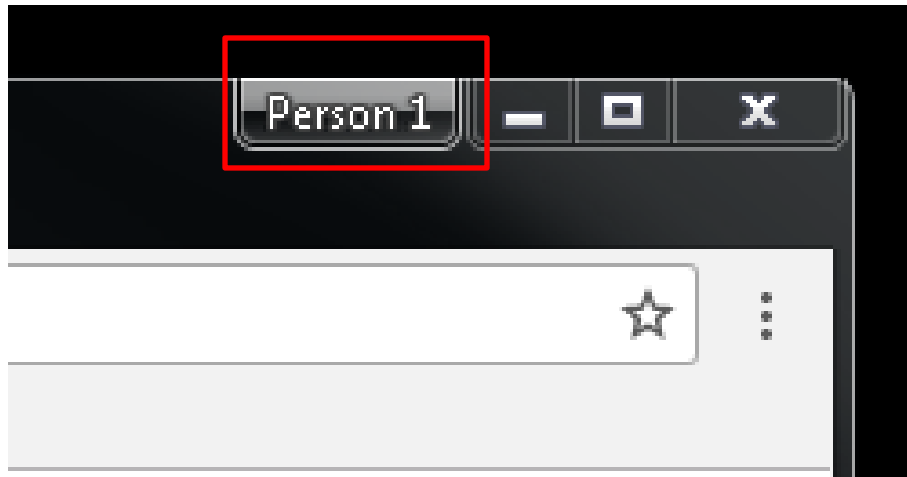
Logging into the Chrome Browser

Note: These directions are for students/staff who log into a device that is NOT a Chromebook.

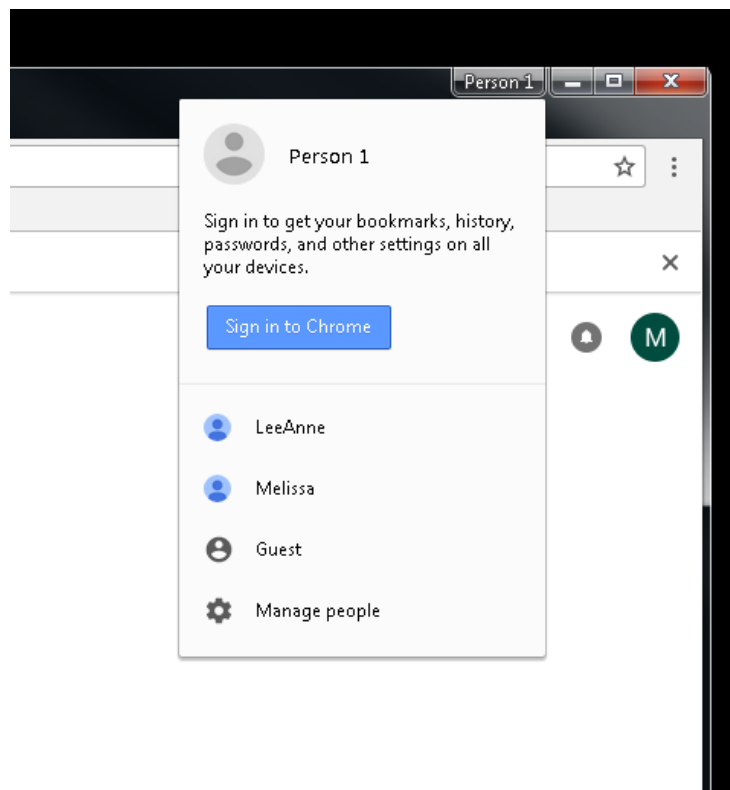
Students are automatically logged into Chrome when using a Chromebook.

Open the Chrome Browser.

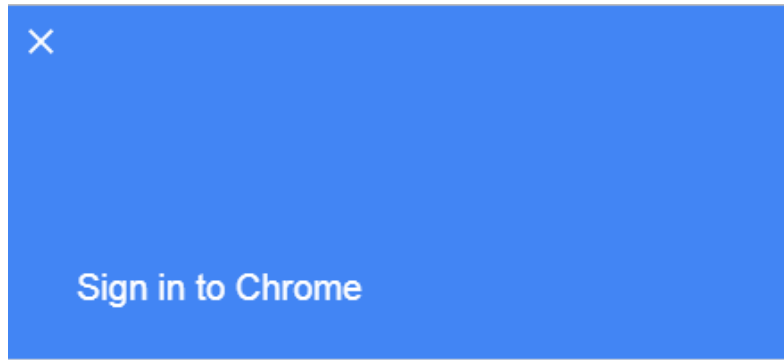
In the upper right hand corner, click on the person icon to the left of the minimizer tab.
