SABOLD SCHOOL PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT	
1. Purpose	<p>In accordance with the Board’s philosophy to provide a quality educational program, the Harvey C. Sabold Elementary School shall provide an appropriate planned instructional program for all students. The school recognizes that parental involvement contributes to the achievement of academic standards by students participating in all aspects of educational programming.</p>
2. School Responsibility	<p>The Harvey C. Sabold Elementary School views the education of students as a cooperative effort among the school, parents/guardians and community. Sabold School develops activities that promote the schools' and parents'/guardians’ capacity for strong parental involvement.</p> <p>Sabold School adopts the following academic goals, which will be used as the foundation for the development of student learning and outcomes to be attained by students.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Each student shall become proficient in reading, writing, listening, speaking, understanding, interpreting, analyzing and synthesizing information. - Out school will help students develop capabilities, talents, self-understanding and a feeling of self-worth and acknowledge students for effort and achievement. <p>The Principal or designee shall ensure that information and reports provided to parents/guardians are in an understandable and uniform format and, to the extent practicable, in a language the parents/guardians can understand.</p>
3. Parent Responsibility	<p>A parent or guardian of a child in Harvey C. Sabold Elementary School should provide their children with an environment which supports interest in their educational program through activities (listening, reading, etc) which will foster learning.</p> <p>Parent can also assist by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - monitoring attendance - monitoring homework - promoting positive use of extracurricular time - participating in school related activities - monitoring amount of television a child watches - volunteering in child’s classroom - checking for notices and communications coming through student from school
