

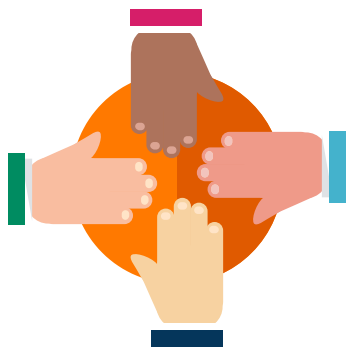
ETR Summer Leadership Camp
